Exempted from the obligatory German insurance are all students with European health insurance and EHIC. Travel health insurance: non-EU citizens should have travel health insurance at least valid until the start of lectures. Please be aware that international travel insurances are not sufficient and will not be approved by FAU and German authorities.
