Register at your city's Resident's Registration Office
Put your name on your letter box
If needed apply for your residence permit (does not apply to everyone!)
Open a bank account
Connect with your buddy
Find your local supermarket, pharmacy, shopping area, etc. (Please take note that all shops are entirely closed on Sundays as well as on <u>public holidays</u>)
Activate your <u>IdM</u> account
If you are living in a dormitory, hand in your enrolment certificate to the Housing Service (Download on <u>Campo</u>)
Buy your <u>Deutschland Ticket</u> for public transport
