

## Frequently asked questions about the Eva Schleip Scholarship

### Who is eligible for funding?

- The foundation supports students studying for an undergraduate degree who are German citizens, have been raised as Christians (Protestant or Catholic), and are in financial need.
- Guest students and students pursuing a second or additional degree are not eligible for funding.

### How much funding is awarded?

The study grant is 500 euros and is awarded as a one-time payment.

### How many times a year is funding awarded?

Study grants are usually awarded once a year.

### How often can I receive this funding?

Funding is only awarded once.

### Is the funding tied to a specific purpose?

No. The scholarship is not earmarked for a specific purpose.

### How do I prove my financial need?

By uploading your BAföG confirmation letter or by providing a list of your income.

### Can I receive financial aid without proof of BAföG?

Yes. If you do not receive BAföG, you must provide proof of how you cover your living expenses.

### Will the scholarship be counted toward my BAföG?

No. The scholarship must be declared, but it is below the threshold.

### Proof of a Christian upbringing

One of the following documents must be submitted as proof of a Christian upbringing: Baptism certificate, confirmation certificate for the Protestant Church, first communion certificate, confirmation certificate from the Catholic Church. The certificate must be issued by the relevant parish office.

### Merit-based principle

A scholarship can be awarded to anyone who has passed the intermediate or preliminary examination (GOP, intermediate examination, or Physikum) required for the first part of their degree program no later than one semester after the minimum period of study specified in the degree program and examination regulations. Master's students must be progressing through their program in accordance with requirements in order to be eligible.

### Can the scholarship be combined with the Deutschlandstipendium?

Yes.

### Am I eligible for funding if I am currently on a leave of absence from my studies?

No.
